ANNOUNCEMENT OF 2017 SUBSPECIALTY EXAMINATIONS DEADLINE TO APPLY SEPTEMBER 1, 2016

The American Osteopathic Board of Radiology (AOBR) offers examinations in the following subspecialties leading to Certification of Added Qualifications:

1. Neuroradiology
2. Pediatric Radiology
3. Vascular and Interventional Radiology

The examination process consists of one (1) computerized examination. Candidates will be given 3 hours to complete the exam. The 2017 CAQ examination will be offered twice (once in the spring & once in the fall).

Application Fee:	\$1,250	Due September 1 prior to examination (NON-REFUNDABLE)
Exam Fee:	\$2,200	Due February 1 prior to examination
Late Application Fee:	\$ 500	Any application postmarked between September 2 and December 1
Reexamination Fee	\$1,800	Due February 1 prior to examination

(No applications will be accepted after December 1 for exam the following year)

The following documentation listed below must be in the AOBR Office by **September 1** of the previous year in which an applicant wishes to begin the examination process in order to be considered for examination (i.e. September 1, 2013, for the 2014 examinations):

1. Application form with one (1) **current** photographs (typewritten or computer generated)
2. Application fee of \$1,250 (NON-REFUNDABLE)
3. Examination Applicant Release Statement
4. Letter from fellowship training program that verifies training dates (only for those currently in training)

Candidates must be a member in good standing of the AOA at the time of the application. Candidates are responsible for keeping their AOA membership dues paid in a timely manner.

Training in Neuroradiology, Pediatric Radiology, and Vascular and Interventional Radiology must be completed in an AOA or ACGME accredited program. **Candidates must be in their final year of fellowship training or training complete at the time of examination to be eligible.** Applicants who have completed fellowship training must have AOA approval. Candidates successfully completing the certification examination process will be issued a 10-year time limited certificate, and will be required to comply with Osteopathic Continuous Certification (OCC) requirements in order to maintain their certification.
